

Additional Information on the Location of the Dog Bins for the Village

The issue of installing Dog Waste Bin in the village was first raised in April 2022 and the various locations were discussed as possible sites –

- Junction of Station Road and Lodge Hill Currently being discussed but a section 171 permit is required as the land is owned by Somerset County Council
- Vicinity of the School / Shop disregarded as too close to the School / Shop
- Rough More Lane next to the Playground disregarded as might encourage dogs onto the Playing Fields and they are currently not allowed
- Junction of Lynch Lane and Broadway Lane unable to remember the reason why this was disregarded
- Junction of Kites Croft and Drapnel Lane Currently being discussed but a section 171 permit is required as the land is owned by Somerset County Council
- Bottom of Lychcombe Lane unable to remember the reason why this was disregarded
- Deer Leap Car Park This is AONB land and permission would need to be sought from them
- Junction of Short Drove and Long Drove Environmental Services will not be able to empty this one as it not on the route.
- On the Corner of the entrance to Stoneleigh Currently being discussed but a section 171 permit is required as the land is owned by Somerset County Council

As a result, there were three possible sites for serious consideration

- Junction of Station Road and Lodge Hill
- Junction of Kites Croft and Drapnel Lane
- On the corner of the entrance to Stoneleigh

All these three sites require a section 171 permit at £250 per site, unless Councillors would like to consider locations which are on private land but they would still require permission from the landowner.
