





Which area of the village do you live in 255 responses















How often, in an average week, do you walk across the A371 (count walking along without a pavement as crossing)




How often in an average week do you drive along the A371 240 responses




Would you normally drive if 247 responses



Do you have difficulty finding a parking space in the village ²⁴² responses






If safe off-road routes were available would you be likely to reduce car use by













For you personally, from where would the development create a significant visual impact 253 responses




Should the existing Roughmoor lane access onto the A371 243 responses
